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STORY EXTENSION IDEAS

- Create two cardboard ramps from shipping boxes and race plastic eggs down them. Fill the eggs with different things to see if it makes them go faster or slower.
- Create a [Tangled Wool Sheep](#)
- Use your nose to roll plastic eggs down a flat path. Use a timer to see who can get to the end the fastest.
- Complete an obstacle course while balancing a hard-boiled egg on a spoon.

IDEA OF THE DAY

Writing Letters

1. Try writing in shaving cream. Cover a cookie sheet with shaving cream. Have your child practice writing their name and other alphabet letters with their finger in the shaving cream. If your child doesn't want to use their finger they can use an unsharpened pencil instead.
2. Go outside and practice writing with sidewalk chalk.
3. Fill a gallon size Ziploc bag with hair gel. Remove all the air and seal the bag shut. Have your child press with their finger outside the bag to make letters. This works especially well if the bag is taped on a window.
