STORY EXTENSION IDEAS

IDEA OF THE DAY **MELTED CRAYONS**

If you have old, broken crayons hanging around, then you have an instant craft project! Reuse those old crayons by making them new again. Unwrap the crayons, arrange them in a muffin tin in a single layer, and cook in the oven on 200 degrees for about 10 minutes. Let cool, then stick them in the freezer to make it easier to pop them out. Just turn the pan over and you'll have new cool, round crayons. Note: When the crayons are fresh out of the freezer, they may not color well. Warm them up in your hands to get them going.
