Make Emotions Discovery Jars.

Fill empty plastic jars or bottles with water, glitter, food coloring, or whatever you have on hand, making each jar a different color. With face stickers or markers, create faces that correspond with different emotions. Disney's movie "Inside Out" is a good model for this game with Joy, Sadness, Anger, Fear, and Disgust. Use the bottles to communicate to your child how you're feeling that day, and have them do the same.
