## **STORY EXTENSION IDEAS**

- -UNICORN GOOP: Prepare this mysterious texture. Children will love manipulating it! Recipe: 3/4 cup of cornstarch 1/3 cup of water Food coloring (pastel colors) Combine the water and the food coloring. Slowly add the cornstarch without mixing. Using your hands, press the goop until it forms a ball. Open your hand and the goop will become liquid again.
