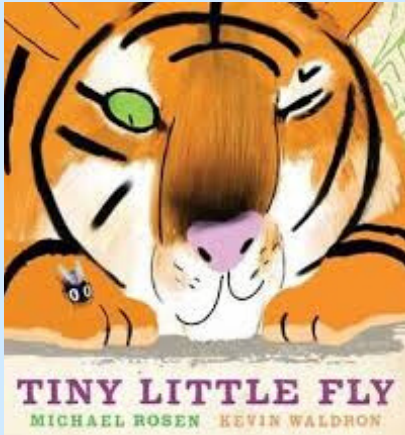


TINY LITTLE FLY

BUILD A BUG

Using construction paper in a variety of colors, cut your bug pieces. You'll need small holes (can use a hole punch) for eyes, spots, and antennae tops. You'll need circles (can cut in different sizes) and semi-circles for bug bodies and heads. And finally, you'll need skinny strips for legs, antennae, stripes, and mouths. Let your child create their own bugs using these materials, a paper for the background and a glue stick.
